- LSERS celebrated 70 years. LSERS was created in 1946 when House Bill No. 154 was introduced by, then Louisiana Legislator J. Howard Lafleur and Le Fontenot, and enacted as Act 124. LSERS became fully operational on July 1, 1947. The first retirement benefits became effective August 1, 1948 and by the end of 1948-49 fiscal year, 252 retirees were receiving benefits. 70 years after its creation, LSERS provides benefits to more than 13,000 retirees and beneficiaries.
